## **Trending Legislative Topics**




A quick scan of the news shows that states are legislatively concentrating on the environment, pension funds, workplace laws and medical marijuana. But what's going on legislatively at the local level?

What are 'Form-Based Codes'? As defined by the Local Government Commission (LGC), form-based codes place primary emphasis on building type, dimensions, parking location and facade features, and less emphasis on segregating land use types. They stress the appearance of the streetscape over long lists of different use types.
